WATER SYSTEM FEE SCHEDULE

Residential Water User Fee:

Quarterly Fixed Service Charge	\$/Unit	\$32.00
Usage Fee (0-15,000 gals)	\$/1,000 gals	\$ 1.70
Usage Fee (15,001 - 40,000 gals)	\$/1,000 gals	\$ 3.10
Usage Fee (40,001 gals and over)	\$/1,000 gals	\$ 4.20

USER CHARGE - COMMERCIAL

Minimum \$60.00 per unit, per quarter due at the end of the Quarter.

Usage \$4.20 per 1,000 gallon

CONNECTION FEES:

\$3,100.00 per EDU (Equivalent Dwelling Unit).

COMMERCIAL WATER CONNECTION FEE CALCULATION

Definition of Equivalent Dwelling Unit: Each commercial or nonresidential user whose estimated or actual water consumption does not exceed 165 gallons per day or 60,000 gallons per year. For connection fee calculation purposes, the number of units shall be calculated to the nearest tenth (1/10) unit, and multiplied by the single unit charge. The charges shall be subject to adjustment after one year of actual usage history has been established.

METER FEES: \$250.00 Radio Read Meter (5/8 X 3/4")

\$350.00 Radio Read Meter (1" Meter)

Larger Meters Market Price

Property Owner responsible for furnishing and installation of meter yoke and associated valving.

APPLICATION FEES:

Tentative Review - 1% of estimated project cost; minimum fee \$200.00

Preliminary Review - 1 1/2% of estimated project cost; minimum fee \$200.00

Final Review - 1% of estimated project cost; minimum fee \$200.00

INSPECTION FEES:

Subdivision/Development - 5% of estimated project cost

ADDITIONAL FEES:

The Applicant shall reimburse the Township of Ocean, Department of Utilities for all engineering, legal, environmental, consultant and other administrative costs incurred by the Utility Department in connection with the review, inspection, acceptance or rejection of Applicant's Utility Systems and conveyance of the same to the Utility Department which are in excess of the application and inspection fees paid by the Applicant. Such additional fees shall be paid by the Applicant in accordance with the procedures set forth in the Township of Ocean, Department of Utilities' Rules and Regulations.
